**Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Oil and Natural Gas Corporation has identified some locations in its ageing oil fields on the West coast for re-development;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the ONGC has assessed the production feasibility of these locations before re-development;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the amount sanctioned for this purpose?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE FOR PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI DINSHA PATEL)

(a to e) Improved Oil recovery (IOR) and Enhanced Oil Recovery (EOR) projects, namely, Mumbai High North, Mumbai High South, and Additional Development at Heera Part-II are being implemented by ONGC in the west Coast areas of the country. The incremental oil of 63.225 Metric Million Tonnes (MMT) and 20.893 Billion Cubic Million (BCM) of gas is expected from these projects by 2030. The total cost of implementation of these IOR/EOR projects will be about Rs.11,298.28 crores.
