- (c) whether the available infrastructure and facilities are sufficient to cater to the increase in intake to these institutes; and
- (d) if not, the action proposed to be taken in this regards?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 59 FOR 21.02.2006 ASKED BY DR. M. JAGANNATH REGARDING INTAKE OF STUDENTS IN IIMs AND IITs

(a) & (b): The decision regarding increase in intake of students in IIMs and IITs is taken by the Governing Bodies of these Institutes. Intake in Undergraduate and Postgraduate programmes of the 7 IITs, taken together, has shown an upward trend during last three years. Similarly, intake in Postgraduate Programme in Management of the 6 IIMs, taken together, has also shown an upward trend during the same period.

(c) & (d): Upgradation of infrastructure in these Institutes is a continuous process. They endeavour to ensure that no student suffers for lack of infrastructure.
