- (b) the names of schemes in force and the target set for beneficiaries, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to increase the expenditure on such Schemes; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d): At present, there is no Social Security Scheme for general application for the unorganized sector workers in the country. However, some of the State Governments and Ministry of Labour & Employment in the Central Government run few schemes targeting specific sections of the unorganized sector workers.
