(a) to (c) During the current financial year (2005-06), a proposal was received from Government of Tamil Nadu for Hogenakkal Water Supply and Sanitation project for Dharmapuri and Krishnagiri districts at a cost of Rs.1056.65 crores. The project has been kept in Rolling Plan 2006-08 Official Development Assistance (ODA) package for posing the same to Government of Japan for Japan Bank of International Cooperation (JBIC) Loan assistance.
