Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to involve Panchayati Raj Institutions in Rural Development Sector;
- (b) if so, the names of schemes and programmes of Rural Development to be entrusted to these institutions; and
- (c) the initiative taken by the Government to prepare separate Tribal sub-plan of each programme and scheme for tribal areas to be implemented and executed through PESA of Fifth Scheduled Areas ?

Answer

- (a) & (b) The Ministry of Rural Development implements the Sampoorna Gramin Rozgar Yojana (SGRY), National Food For work Programme (NFFWP) and Watershed Projects through the active involvement of Panchayati Raj Institutions.
- (c) The Ministry has made specific provisions in the guidelines of the programmes viz Sampoorna Gramin Rozgar Yojana (SGRY), Swarnjayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojana (SGSY), Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY), Accelerated Rural Water Supply Programme (ARWSP) and Central Rural Sanitation Programme (CRSP)/ Total Sanitation Campaign (TSC) being implemented in the rural areas including tribal areas to ensure adequate flow of resources to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
