**Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether a proposal for establishment of a Krishi Vigyan Kendra at Karamchedu in Andhra Pradesh is pending with the Government for quite a long time;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the proposal is likely to be implemented?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI KANTI LAL BHURIA)

(a), (b) & (c): Government has approved the establishment of a Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) in each of the 578 rural districts of the country. A KVK under Acharya N.G. Ranga Agricultural University is already functioning in Darsi in Prakasam district of Andhra Pradesh. Hence there is no further proposal to sanction a second KVK in the same district.
