Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the fact that over Rs.300 crores released under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme Swarna Jayanti Shahari Rozgar Yojana during the year 2005-06 have not been fully utilised by various States and Union Territories;
- (b) if so, the details of such States and Union Territories; and
- (c) the main reasons for not utilising the fund?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN EMPLOYMENT & POVERTY ALLEVIATION (KUMARI SELJA)

(a)to(c): Under the Scheme of Swarna Jayanti Shahari Rozgar Yojana (SJSRY), the total Central allocation for 2005-06 was Rs.160.00 crore only. Out of this, Rs.158.88 Crore was released to the State Governments for the implementation of the scheme. As per the procedure prescribed by the Government, States/UTs have to furnish Utilization Certificates (UCs) for the grants released to them within 12 months from the end of the financial year in which the grant is released. Thus States/UTs have time till 31.3.2007 to utilize this amount released in 2005-06 and furnish the UCs for the same to the Central Government.
