- (a) whether the Government has received any proposal from the Government of Gujarat for development of Ten Sub City;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the present Status of the proposal?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI AJAY MAKEN)

(a)to(c): No, Sir. The Government of Gujarat has not submitted any proposal for development of Ten Sub City. However, projects related to water supply have been received from 17 towns of Gujarat under Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Small and Medium Towns (UIDSSMT) during the year 2005-06, out of which projects related to 9 towns, namely Kheda, Mehsana, Kadi, Godhra, Radhan, Himmatnagar, Prantij, Surendranagar, and Valsad have been approved and 1st installment of Central share amounting to Rs.198.64, 376.30, 209.40, 578.61, 89.81, 325.97, 111.97, 306.05 and 247.43 lakhs respectively has been released, totaling to Rs.24.44 crores.
