ASSISTANCE FOR JAWAHARLAL NEHRU NATIONAL URBAN RENEWAL MISSION

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Asian Development Bank (ADB) has agreed to provide assistance for Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the terms and conditions; and
- (c) the names of various cities likely to be benefited from such assistance?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI AJAY MAKEN)

(a)to(c): Yes, Sir. Asian Development Bank (ADB) has agreed to provide Technical Assistance to Ministry of Urban Development for implementation of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM). Out of total Technical Assistance of \$ 2.50 million, ADB`s Technical Assistance Funding Programme will be to the tune of \$ 2.00 million whereas the Government of India`s contribution of \$ 0.5 million will be in the form of counter-part staff support, office accommodation, facilities for meetings and workshops and other administrative expenses. The Government of India is also required to provide all information and logistic support required for the Technical Assistance activities. The Technical Assistance is meant for strengthening capacity of Ministry of Urban Development for effective and speedy implementation of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM). It is, therefore, expected to benefit all the cities covered under the Mission.
