CONSTRUCTION OF MUNIRABAD- MEHABOOB NAGAR BG RAILWAY LINE

- (a) the present status of construction of new broad gauge railway line from Munirabad to Mehaboob Nagar;
- (b) the amount spent on the said project, till date; and
- (c) the time schedule fixed for completion of the project?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R.VELU)

(a) to (c) : Munirabad-Mahbubnagar new line (246 kms) project has 230 km. of new line and 16 km. of doubling. Yeramaras-Yadalapur (14.5 km.) doubling has been completed and commissioned. Land acquisition, earthwork and bridge works have been taken up. An amount of Rs.31.9 crore has been spent on this project upto 31.03.2006. No target date has been fixed for the project. The work will be completed in the coming years as per the availability of resources.
