(a) National AIDS Control Programme is a 100% centrally sponsored scheme being implemented all over the country through various State AIDS Control Societies. The funds released to the states during the last three years is at Annexure.

(b) & (c) Apart from the funds provided by National AIDS Control Organisation as at serial no. 11 of Annexure, funds have also been provided by DFID directly to the tune of Rs. 103.72 lakh for Kerala Condom Promotion Project in the year 2004 – 05.
