- (a) whether the Government is aware of the anti-India campaign being run by the High Commission of Pakistan situated in other countries and also the protection being provided to the terrorists by them;
- (b) if so, the number of such cases brought to the notice of the Union Government during the last three years;
- (c) whether the Government has taken up the matter with the concerned countries;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the reaction of the concerned countries thereto?

(a) - (e) Government is aware that contrary to well-established norms of diplomatic behaviour, Pakistan has been using its High Commissions and Embassies in third countries for anti-India propaganda. Government have appropriately and effectively brought to the attention of the concerned countries facts regarding the hostile activities of Pakistani High Commissions and Embassies against India.
