CONSTRUCTION OF BRIDGES OVER NATIONAL HIGHWAYS

**Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) The details of the bridges constructed on various national highways in the country particularly in Uttar Pradesh during each of the last three years and the current year; and
- (b) The State-wise number of bridges proposed to be constructed during the current financial year and the funds likely to be allocated for the purpose?

**Answer**

- (a) The number of bridges constructed on various National Highways in the country during each of last three years and the current year, including those in Uttar Pradesh are at Annexure-I.
- (b) The State-wise number of bridges proposed to be constructed during the current financial year i.e. 2006-07 are at Annexure-II. Funds are allocated State-wise for the development of National Highways for all the schemes including construction of bridges. No separate allocation of funds is made for construction of bridges. The State-wise allocation of funds for development of National Highways under all the schemes during the current financial year i.e. 2006-07 are also at Annexure-II.
