MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRIS. S. PALANIMANICKAM)

(a): National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) has reported that it had received a total number of 593 proposals for minor irrigation, medium irrigation, mral bridges and rural roads projects from the State Government of Orissa during the last three years. The year-wise details of the same are indicated below:

(b): The details of the amount sanctioned to Orissa during the last three years are given below:

(c), (d) & (e): Sixty nine proposals of State Government of Orissa received in March 2004, for rural road and bridge projects worth Rs.104.39 crore are pending with NABARD for sanction.
