Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the funds allocated to States under the `Balika Samridhi Yojana` during 2003- 04, State-wise;
- (b) whether the funds have been released to all the States particularly to the State of Madhya Pradesh under the scheme;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (d) if not, the reasons for delay; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government to release the funds to States?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATIKANTI SINGH)

- (a) No allocation have been made to States/UTs during 2003-2004 under the Scheme.
- (b)&(c) A Statement is annexed.
- (d)&(e) No allocation of funds from 2000-2001 onwards could be made due to a large amount of unspent balance lying with the states. Meanwhile, considering the operational requirements of the scheme, it was decided that issue of transfer of scheme to the states be placed before National Development Council. So far no final decision on this issue has been taken. However, in the current financial year funds are being released to the states who have sent satisfactory utilization certificates.
