KILLING OF OWN COLLEAGUE BY PERSONNEL OF PMF

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of incidents of attacks/killings of their own colleagues/senior officers by the personnel of PMF during the last one year, force-wise, till date;
- (b) whether any psycho analytical studies have been made by the Government to identify the reasons behind such incidents;
- (c) if so, the findings thereof; and
- (d) the corrective measures taken by the Government to avoid such incidents?

Answer

(a): The total number of incidents of attacks/killings of their own colleagues /senior officers by the personnel of Central Police Forces (CPFs) during the last one year, till date, is as under:

(b) & (c) Psychoanalytical study has been conducted in sample cases, revealing the prevalence of `stress` amongst force personnel, particularly when they return from leave.

(d) Steps taken by Government to overcome `stress` in Force personnel include grant of frequent leave, adequate rest, periodic rotation from hard to soft areas, increased recreational facilities and accommodation, organizing outdoor sports & Yóga, improving inter-personal relationship, counselling, etc.
