- 1 101 Out of total length of 65 km, 35 km is in bad condition due to large potholes amounting to Rs.29.98 crore have been sanctioned for improvement and balance 30 km is in traffic worthy condition.
- 2 24 The road is in traffic worthy condition. Road is maintained in traffic worthy condition. Four laning of Lucknow-Sitapur section have been taken up.
- 3 1 The road is in traffic worthy condition. Road is maintained in traffic worthy condition. Widening of Jalandhar-Amritsar section have been taken up.
- 4 2 Road is in traffic worthy condition except some portion between Barwa Adda to Panagarh in West Bengal. The road is being maintained in traffic worthy condition. NH-2 is a part of Golden Quadrilateral of the National Highways Development Project and four laning works have been taken up.
