INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS FROM HYDERABAD AIRPORT .

**Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of the International air services being operated to and from Hyderabad airport at present;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to start some more International air services from Hyderabad; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION ( SHRI PRAFUL PATEL )

(a): At present, 9 foreign airlines viz. Emirates (UAE), Lufthansa German Airlines (Germany), Malaysia Airlines (Malaysia), Qatar Airways (Qatar), Saudi Arabian Airlines (Saudi Arabia), Singapore Airlines (Singapore), Sri Lankan Airlines (Sri Lanka), KLM (Netherlands) and Oman Air (Oman) are providing international connectivity from their respective countries to/from Hyderabad. So far as Indian scheduled carriers are concerned, they are providing international connectivity to/from Hyderabad to 9 foreign countries viz. UK, USA, Germany, Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, Oman, UAE, Singapore and Thailand.

(b) and (c): The Government has granted Hyderabad as point of call to 15 foreign countries. However, actual operation of any airlines to/from any particular point is always guided by its commercial judgement.
