DIRECT AIR SERVICE BETWEEN TRIVANDRUM AND DELHI .

**Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Indian Airlines has discontinued the direct air service between Trivandrum and Delhi for last two months;
- (b) if so, the details and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps proposed to be taken to restore the said direct air service?

**Answer**

(a) and (b): Due to operational constraints, Indian Airlines` flight I C 167 operating o n Delhi-Mumbai- Trivandrum sector was rescheduled effective 6th April, 2006 to operate on Mumbai-Trivandrum sector. However, the return flight, IC 168 operating on Trivandrum- Mumbai-Delhi sector remained unchanged.

(c): The Delhi-Mumbai-Trivandrum flight has since been restored effective 1st August, 2006.
