HI TECH SECURITY EQUIPMENT AT AIRPORTS .

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the airports in the country where CISF has been deployed for security purpose;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to install hi-tech security equipments at the airports;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the expenditure likely to be incurred thereon; and
- (e) the time by which these are likely to be installed?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL)

(a) CISF has been deployed at 54 airports till date.

(b) to (d): Yes, Sir. It has been decided to install security equipments like Bio-metric access control system, Explosive detection equipment, CCTV, Perimeter intrusion detection system etc. at all the major airports in the country. The security equipments being installed at departure area and their cost are as under:-

In line X-Ray Baggage Inspection System - Rs.58.30 crores
Explosive Trace Detectors - Rs.62.27 crores
Metal Detectors - Rs.5.77 crores
X-Ray Baggage Inspection System - Rs.34.00 crores

(e) These equipments will be installed in a phased manner.
