(b) if so, the details of such projects and the present status of each of these projects, State-wise?

**Answer**

(a) Water Sector restructuring/ improvement projects aimed at improving system performance, efficiency and strengthening agricultural support services, setting up and enabling institutional and policy framework for water sector reform and involvement of users, are being implemented with the World Bank assistance in the States of Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra. In addition, Andhra Pradesh Water Sector Improvement Project and Tamil Nadu Water Resources Consolidation Project-II have been recommended to the World Bank for support.
