## Will the Minister of SMALL SCALE INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a): the total number of Integrated Infrastructure Development Centres (IIDCs) functioning at present in the country;
- (b): the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c): whether the Government are contemplating to set up more IID Centres in the country;
- (d): if so, the details thereof;
- (e): the amount of funds likely to be spent thereon;
- (f): the package given to each State and particularly Gujarat to strengthen the small scale sector and enhance the competitiveness both domestically and globally; and
- (g): the steps taken by the Union Government to develop infrastructure for the small scale industries?

## **Answer**

MINISTER OF SMALL SCALE INDUSTRIES & AGRO AND RURAL INDUSTRIES ( SHRI MAHABIR PRASAD )

- (a)&(b): A Statement showing state-wise details of 27 Integrated Infrastructural Development(IID) Centres, which are functional/operational in country, is at Annexure.
- (c)to(e): Under the provisions of the IID Scheme, the State Governments/Union Territories are required to select appropriate sites for setting up IID Centres, prepare projects reports and submit these to Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) for technoeconomic appraisal. On the basis of the appraisal report of SIDBI, the Central Government sanctions the setting up of IID Centres.
- (f): While development of SSI is primarily the responsibility of the State/UT Government, the Central Government has taken several steps to improve their performance and enhance their competitiveness both domestically and globally by implementing various schemes including those for enhanced fiscal and credit support, infrastructural development, technology upgradation, marketing entrepreneurial development etc. The schemes/programmes for the promotion of Small Scale Sector are uniformally implemented across the country including Gujarat.
- (g): The Government has amended the IID Scheme to progressively cover the entire country with 50% reservation for rural areas. The funding pattern for the Scheme has also been suitably modified to enhance the quantum of central grant from 40% to 80% in respect of North-Eastern Region(including Sikkim), Jammu & Kashmir(J&K), Himachal Pradesh and Uttranchal.
