- (a) whether the Government has discontinued the policy of constructing houses in Delhi for the middle class people;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether DDA had withdrawn the plan to constructed flats for middle class people in Dwarka, Sheikh Sarai and Rohini; and
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI AJAY MAKEN)

(a)to(d): The Delhi Development Authority (DDA) has informed that the policy of constructing houses in Delhi for middle class people has not been discontinued. In the recently launched `DDA Housing Scheme 2006`, 2352 two bed room houses have been offered for allotment for middle class people. In addition, 1343 MIG and 6852 LIG houses are under construction by DDA as on date.
