Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) The details of the basic facilities for which Union Government provide assistance to State under SSA;
- (b) Whether National Institute for Education Planning and Research has made any survey to find out hurdles in achieving the targets of SSA as reported in Hindustan dated July 15, 2006;
- (c) If so, the details of the findings of such survey; and
- (d) The steps taken by the Government to provide basic amenities in school?

Answer

THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. D. PURANDESWARI)

- (a) The Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) provides inputs for access, retention and quality improvement in schools including items of school infrastructure within a ceiling of 33% of outlay for school buildings, additional classrooms, toilets, drinking water facilities etc.
- (b)&(c) No, Sir. Every year data is collected from every Government, Government-aided and private recognised schools in elementary education under the District Information System for Education (DISE), which is analysed by the National Institute for Educational Planning and Administration (NIEPA) and published. The details of the analyses of NIEPA are available on their website <http://www.dpepmis.org>.
- (d) Under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan programme 1,20,629 school buildings, 3,29,690 additional class rooms, 1,61,764 drinking water facilities and 2,22,071 toilets have been sanctioned till the year 2005-06.
