- (a) the number of places throughout the country where toll tax is being charged on the National Highways at present;
- (b) the details in this regard; and
- (c) the amount collected as toll tax from the National Highways so far?

**Answer**

(a)&(b) The users' fee (toll) is collected on 23 sections of the National Highways. The details in respect of bridges and other projects are being collected.

(c) The total amount of users' fee (toll) collected by the Government of India so far since 1976-77 till July, 2004 is Rs 892.39 Crore. In addition, National Highways Authority of India has collected Rs 966.66 Crore as users' fees up to June, 2004, on the National Highways entrusted to them.
