(b) & (c) Yes, Sir. Proficiency/Competency in teaching through Hindi and English is an essential qualification for appointment to the posts of Post Graduate Teachers and Trained Graduate Teachers in Kendriya Vidyalayas since nineties and for Primary Teachers since eighties. Upto the recruitment year 2002-2003, the knowledge of Hindi and English was being assessed through interview. From the recruitment year 2003-2004 proficiency/competency of teaching through Hindi and English is being tested through bi-lingual test in Hindi and English.
