Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the time by when the conversion of National Highways Nos. 8 and 69 in Rajasthan into 4 or 6 lanes would be completed under the Golden Quadrilateral Scheme;
- (b) the amount utilized in the construction of National Highways passing through Rajasthan under the Golden Quadrilateral Scheme;
- (c) whether any request was made by the villagers for leaving passages for cattle and paths in order to provide free passages for easy movement at various places between Jaipur-Kishangarh and Kishangarh-Vijaynagar;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) the places where the request for free passages have been accepted;
- (f) whether the Government has received any representation in this regard; and
- (g) if so, the details thereof and the action taken thereon?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

- (a) Golden Quadrilateral in the state of Rajasthan comprises of sections of National Highway (NH) 8, NH-76, NH-79 and NH-79A and is targeted to be substantially completed by December, 2004. NH-69 is not a part of Golden Quadrilateral.
- (b) The amount utilized is Rs. 2307.11 crore.
- (c) Yes, Sir.
- (d) to (g) 11 number of requests/ representations were received in this regard, out of which underpasses at 4 locations namely Dantari, Nauharia, Srinagar and village Baral II have been provided.
