(b): A total amount of Rs.484.58 lakh has been sanctioned during the year 2005-06 for Integrated Development of Attari Wagha Border as a destination which includes Development of Attari Wagha Border, Neem Chameli Complex, Attari Mahal, Samadhi Complex, Attari International Railway Station, Ram Tirath Temple Complex, Pul Kanjari, Sarai Amanat Khan Complex and Raja Sansi Village Carpet Weaver Complex.

(c): Implementation and completion of projects sanctioned under various schemes of the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India is the responsibility of the State Government. Ministry of Tourism, Government of India monitors the progress of the projects and status of utilization of funds through review meetings from time to time.
