RE-EMPLOYMENT OF CASUAL WORKERS

Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the Government has received any proposal regarding revival and re-employment of 168 Badli and Casual Workers in the Government of India Undertaking, Sri Yallamma Cotton Woollen and Silk Mills, Tholahunase, Davangere, Karnataka;
- (b) if so, whether the Government has considered the proposal;
- (c) if so, the help and assistance being provided by the Government to the mills for its revival;
- (d) whether all the Badali and Casual Workers have been re-employed;
- (e) if not, the reasons therefore; and
- (f) time by which all the Badali and Casual Workers will be provided re-employment?

Answer

MINISTER OF TEXTILES (SHRI SHANKERSINH VAGHELA)

(a) to (f): 71 Badli workers in the Sri Yallamma Mills, Davangere, requested NTC to regularize their services as permanent workers. However, such a request can be entertained only when the mill works at full capacity. Till such time, they are being employed as and when there is requirement as per the operational necessity.
