LPG PLANTS OF ONGC

- (a) the details of Liquefied Petroleum Gas plants of the Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Ltd. (ONGC) functioning in the country;
- (b) the installed capacity of each plant and the quantity of LPG produced therein during each of the last three years; and
- (c) the stock position of LPG during the last three years?

(a) : LPG is being produced from natural gas and condensate at the production facilities of Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited (ONGC), at Uran (Maharashtra), Ankleshwar and Gandhar (Gujarat). LPG produced from ONGC sources is currently being transferred to public sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs).
