(b) & (c) The Government of Rajasthan had proposed a special project under Swarnajayanti Gram Swarajgar Yojana (SGSY), for setting up permanent marketing centres in 12 districts (Gramin Haat Phase-II) for sanction. The project proposal was examined in accordance with guidelines for special projects under SGSY and as a similar special project under SGSY for setting up permanent marketing complexes in 10 districts to be executed by the same agency had already been sanctioned in March, 2002 and was yet to be completed, the proposal for starting IInd phase of the project was returned to the State Government indicating that it can be considered only after the first phase is successfully completed and projected results are achieved.
