FOUR LANING OF NATIONAL HIGHWAY NO.215

Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposed for four laning of National Highway No. 215 from Panikoili to Rajamunda;
- (b) if so, the fund to be sanctioned for the purpose; and
- (c) the time by which the four laning work of the said National Highway is likely to be completed?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K. H. MUNIYAPPA)

- (a) Four laning of National Highway No. 215 from Panikoili to Rajamunda is envisaged under National Highway Development Project (NHDP)-III, to be implemented on Build, Operate and Transfer (BOT) basis.
- (b) Preparation of the Detailed Project Report (DPR) is already taken up by National Highways Authority of India and the BOT work is likely to be awarded by December 2006. Fund requirement would be known on completion of the DPR.
- (c) The overall completion of the project is envisaged by December 2009.
