ISSUANCE OF IDENTITY CARDS TO DDA EMPLOYEES

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Delhi Development Authority has decided to digital its employee`s record and issue identity cards to prevent touts from entering DDA offices;
- (b) if so, the number of employees who have been issued such identity cards so far;
- (c) the time required to cover all the employees of DDA; and
- (d) the extent of success achieved to prevent touts from entering DDA offices so far as a result thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI GHULAM NABI AZAD)

(a)to(c): Delhi Development Authority (DDA) has reported that it has decided to computerize employees records as a part of Personnel Management Information System. DDA has been issuing Identity Cards to its employees and during the last five years, 20,549 Identity Cards have been issued/renewed. DDA has also reported that no request for issue/renewal of Identity Card is pending.

(d): DDA has reported that Identity Cards are checked at all the entry gates and the system has been effective in discouraging entry of unauthorized persons.
