PROMOTION OF ORGANIC FARMING

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether a working group was constituted under the Chairmanship of Dr. Kambalji Bhai Jadav to suggest ways for promoting organic fanning and extending its financial benefits to the farmers;
- (b) If so, the findings of the said group;
- (c) Whether the said group recommended for setting up a National Board;
- (d) If so, by when the said Board is likely to be set up;
- (c) Whether the Government has launched the pilot project for promoting organic farming;
- (f) If so, the details thereof; and
- (g) The state-wise measures taken for promotion of organic farming?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI KANTILAL BHUTOA)

- (a) to (c): Yes, Sir. The Department of Agriculture & Cooperation has set up a Task Force on Organic Farming under the Chairmanship of Dr. Kunwarji Bhai Jadhav in May 2000. The Task Force made the following main recommendations:
- (I) Setting up of a National level permanent board to oversee the promotion of organic farming in the country and to coordinate these activities with all concerned agencies.
- (II) Formulation of National Standards of organic farming in harmonization with international standards.
- (III) Formulation of regulatory mechanism on organic farming .
- (IV) To provide financial assistance for setting up of organic input production units.
- (V) Government support for market development of organic produce in domestic and export market.
- (e): A National Project on Organic Farming for the production, promotion, market development and certification of organic fanning has been approved by the Government on pilot basis for implementation through National Bio-fertilizer Development Centre, Ghaziabad and its six regional centres located at Imphal, Jabalpur, Bhubaneswar, Bangalore, Nagpur & Hissar.
- (f): The main components of the pilot scheme are as under:
- (i) putting in place a system of certification of organic produce.
- (ii) capacity building through service providers .
- (iii) Support through financial assistance for commercial production units of organic inputs .
- (iv) Promotion, extension and market development of organic produce .
- (g): The State Governments have been advised to take necessary steps for promoting organic farming and the guidelines for organic farming has already been circulated to them in July 2002.
