(a) &(b) The Ministry of Rural Development implements the major schemes, namely, the Swarnjayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojana (SGSY), the Sampoorna Gramin Rozgar Yojana (SGRY), the Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY), the Drought Prone Areas Programme (DPAP), the Desert Development Programme (DDP) and the Integrated Watershed Development Programme (IWDP), the Accelerated Rural Water Supply Programme (ARWSP) and the Total Sanitation Campaign (TSC). State-wise and Scheme-wise details of the amounts released by the Ministry of Rural Development during the current financial year i.e. 2004-05 are given in the enclosed Statements
