**Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) Whether any training programme has been made for the police forces of the country to tackle the biological, chemical and radioactive terrorists' attacks ;
- (b) If so, the details thereof; and
- (c) The steps taken by the Government to impart training to the police forces to face the sudden terrorist attacks ?

**Answer**

(a) & (b): Training programmes are organized for CPF personnel to tackle the situation arising out of Nuclear, Biological and Chemical attacks. The training includes :-

- (i) Delivery system
- (ii) Type of radiation
- (iii) Characteristics and type of biological agents.
- (iv) Classification and types of chemical agents.
- (v) Effects of Nuclear, Biological and Chemical Warfare on human beings and equipment.
- (vi) Measures to manage after effects.

(c): Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for responding to terrorist attacks using Chemical Weapons and involving use of Radioactive Materials have been circulated to the concerned Ministries/Departments/Agencies/ Governments and Union Territory administration for drawings up their individual SOPs/Action Plans and also to initiate necessary preparedness measures as mentioned in the said SOPs. Four out of the eight battalions of the National Disaster Response Force have been earmarked specifically for RNBC disaster/terrorist strikes.
