BEAUTIFICATION OF AIRPORTS

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount earmarked and spent on greenery and beautification of various airports during the last two years; and
- (b) the steps being taken for providing greenery at Khajuraho and Babatpur airports in view of the tourists arrival there?

Answer

- MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL)

- (a) The total amount spent by Airports Authority of India (AAI) on greenery and beautification of the airports and offices during the last two years was Rs.1.61 crores and Rs.1.46 crores respectively.
- (b) City side beautification at a cost of Rs.32.80 lakhs and Rs.2.89 lakhs has been completed at Khajuraho and Babatpur (Varanasi) airports respectively. Rs.9 lakhs and Rs.2.49 lakhs have been estimated to spend for development of garden and horticulture maintenance for the year 2006-07 at Khajuraho and Babatpur airports respectively.
