**Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of Indian Airlines flights operating between Hyderabad and other metropolitan cities;
- (b) whether there is any proposal to enhance the number of flights from Hyderabad to other metropolitan cities; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

**Answer**

- MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION ( SHRI PRAFUL PATEL )

(a): Indian Airlines currently operates 14 flights/week from Hyderabad to Bangalore and 21 flights per week each to Chennai, Delhi and Mumbai all with A-320 aircraft. Besides, Indian Airlines` subsidiary, Alliance Air also operates a daily B-737 service on the route Mumbai-Hyderabad-Vizag and return.

(b) and (c): Indian Airlines has plans to introduce/ increase the frequency of operation between Hyderabad and all the other metro cities. The exact number of frequency increase would be based on the estimated traffic that could be generated, commercial viability and the available capacity.
