(a) to (d):The Fact Finding Committee, constituted with the approval of the President of India in his capacity as the Visitor of Mahatma Gandhi Antarrashtriya Hindi Vishwavidyalaya, Wardha, to review the work and progress of the University since its inception has submitted its report. Apart from dealing with the tenure of the first Vice Chancellor, the Committee has made certain recommendations in its report with a view to improving the quality of teaching and learning in the University, developing requisite infrastructure on the University Campus, including construction of hostel, residential accommodation for faculty and staff and expansion of library etc. The Committee has also made certain observations with regard to existing authorities of the University and the need to develop a perspective plan for its future development, for which discussions have been held with the officers of the University Grants Commission and the University on 27th & 28th October, 2006.
