APPOINTMENT OF COMPUTER TEACHERS

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there are no sanctioned/regular posts for computer teachers in the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS);
- (b) if so, whether KVS has hired the services of professional computer teachers on contractual basis;
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether Government proposes to appoint the computer teachers without further delay;
- (e) if so, the steps taken thereon; and
- (f) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

(a) to (f) Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) has 755 sanctioned posts of Post Graduate Teachers in Computer Science for those Vidyalayas which are having higher secondary classes. Till the regular recruits join these posts, the Vidyalayas have to engage suitable persons on contract basis. An advertisement for filling up 755 posts of Post Graduate Teachers (Computer Science) in Kendriya Vidyalayas has already been published in the "Employment News" in its issue dated 30th September 2006.
