Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has introduced a scheme, one family one employment';
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of persons employed in the country under the scheme during each of the last three years, state-wise; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government to provide job to one person from each family under the scheme?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI OSCAR FERNANDES)

(a to d) Central Government has not introduced any scheme called 'One family, one employment'. However, National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme has been launched by Government of India in 200 districts of the country to provide at least 100 days of guaranteed wage employment in every financial year to every household in the rural areas whose adult members volunteer to do unskilled manual work. About 1.5 crore persons have benefited from the scheme up to October, 2006. As regards State Governments, as per the information available with the Ministry of Labour and Employment, no State except Haryana had introduced one family, one employment' scheme.
