**Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether any proposals for setting up of six Ayush specialised clinics at Patera, Madiyada, Sarra, Hinota, Abhana and Kumhari sent by Madhya Pradesh are pending with the Union Government;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the Union Government is likely to accord its approval and the funds likely to be released for the purpose?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. PANABAKA LAKSHMI)

- (a) The proposals have been examined in the Department and have been approved by the Screening Committee.
- (b) The Government of Madhya Pradesh had submitted proposals to the Department of AYUSH for financial assistance of Rs. 10.00 lakhs each for setting up of specialized AYUSH clinics at Patera, Madiyado, Sarra, Hinota, Abhana and Kumhari under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Hospital & Dispensaries.
- (c) The proposal has been approved by the Screening Committee in the Department of AYUSH. However, the Department of AYUSH is unable to release the funds because Utilization Certificates for financial assistance granted earlier have not been received from the Madhya Pradesh Government.
