**Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether any proposal pertaining to construction of a bridge on the Chambal National Highway in Madhya Pradesh is pending with the Union Government;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the time by which the sanction is likely to be given and the expected timeframe for construction of said bridge?

**Answer**

(a) No, Sir.

(b) There is no Chambal National Highway. Chambal river crosses NH-59 in Madhya Pradesh where a bridge already exists. However, there is an existing Chambal Bridge on National Highway No.3, in Rajasthan near MP/Rajasthan border where a new bridge is proposed under National Highway Development Project Phase-II.
