FUNDS FOR POLICE HOUSING

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the Government has received any proposal from the State Government of Karnataka for allocation of Rs. 50 crores towards police housing ;
- (b) If so, the details of the proposal ;
- (c) The time by which final decision in this regard is likely to be taken ;
- (d) Whether the Government has also received such proposal from other States; and
- (e) If so, the details thereof, State-wise ?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI SRIPRAKASH JAISWAL)

(a) to (e): The Government has not received any proposal from the Government of Karnataka for allocation of Rs. 50 crores towards police housing. However, under the Modernization of State Police Forces (MPF) Scheme 2006-07, Government of Karnataka has submitted a proposal, inter-alia, for Central assistance of Rs. 7.96 crores for construction of residential buildings for their police personnel. Central Government has released the said amount in full to the Police Housing Corporation of Karnataka on 30.8.06. Under the MPF Scheme, proposals from all States are considered, including components for police housing, and Central assistance is released as per terms of the Scheme.
