Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Pakistan had allowed import of Iron Sheets from India up to 30th May, 2006 ;
- (b) if so, whether the permission has been granted by the Indian Government;
- (c) whether this is subjected to clearance from Earthquake Reconstruction and Rehabilitation Authority(ERRA); and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY(SHRI JAIRAM RAMESH)

(a)to(d) The Government of Pakistan and Earthquake Reconstruction and Rehabilitation Authority (ERRA) had allowed import of Corrugated Iron Sheets from India through Wagah land border for reconstruction purposes following the earthquake.The initial permission given up to March 31, 2006 was subsequently extended up to September 30, 2006. The Government of India had also allowed the export of Corrugated Iron Sheets.
