RAIL OVERBRIDGE BETWEEN MANGALORE TO SHORNUR

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of rail overbridges between Mangalore to Shornur railway stations where construction work is going on;
- (b) whether the Government is aware that the construction of Nandi Railway over-bridge is running behind schedule;
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the time by which the said work is likely to be completed ?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRIR. VELU)

- (a) 10 numbers of road over bridge works have been taken up for construction, out of which 6 already completed and 4 are in progress. In addition remaining 20 numbers are in planning stage.
- (b) Yes, Sir.
- (c) Work of Nandi Road Over Bridge is being executed by M/s. Roads and Bridges Development Corporation of Kerala (M/s. RBDCK) as a Single Agency. Work is in progress. 1st span on approach portion completed, 2nd is in progress. After completion of approaches, spans work on Railway portion will be taken up by M/s. RBDCK.
- (d) The work is likely to be completed by March,2007.
