(a)Yes, Sir.

(b) UTs of Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu and Chandigarh do not have District Institutes of Education and Training (DIETs). No proposals have been received from these UTs under the revised scheme.

(c) Pre-service training requirements of the above UTs are met by institutions located in them and in adjoining States. As regards in-service training, Block/ Cluster Resource Centres have been sanctioned under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan for this purpose.

(d) Details with regard to the number of Teacher Training Institutions recognised by National Council for Teacher Education, State/UT wise is annexed.
