Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has received some proposals from State Governments particularly from Kamataka for sanctioning and releasing of grants to teachers education for 2004-2005 and upgradation of CTE, Gulbarga as IASE and release of additional quantity of foodgrains at BPL rates for Class VI and VII students under Centrally sponsored schemes ;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State and UT wise; and

(c) the action taken by the Government thereon as on date?

Answer

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF (HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT)(SHRI M.A.A. FATMI)

(a)to (c) Proposals for release of grants under Teacher Education Scheme were received from 21 States/UTs including Kamataka in 2004-05. Details of Central assistance released are given in the Annexe.

For release of Central assistance for upgraded IASE, Gulbarga, Government of Kamataka submitted its proposal, which was not in conformity with the financial ceiling limits prescribed for Civil works and Equipment. State Government has been advised to revise its proposal. The proposal for release of additional quantity of food-grains at BPL rates for Class VI and VII students under Mid Day Meal Scheme has been received only from State of Kamataka. Since Mid-day Meal Scheme covers students of classes I to V only, the proposal could not be agreed to.
