- (a) whether the National Highway. Authority of India has floated tenders for two new highway; building projects recently ;
- (b) if so, the details of the projects and the time by which these two projects are likely to be completed; and
- (c) the status of NHAI projects under construction in the country particularly in Karnataka as on September 2005 ?

(a) and (b) Yes, Sir. National Highways Authority of India (NHA) has floated tenders for works pertaining to National Highways Development Project Phase IIIA and remaining packages of National Highways Development Project Phase II. NHDP Phase II is expected to be completed by December, 2008 and NHDP Phase IIIA is expected to be completed by December,2009.
