Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI AJAY MAKEN)

(a): No, Sir. However, Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) has been signed between the Government of India, the Government of Maharashtra and Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai in respect of Mumbai for implementation of reforms agenda as provided under Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) for seeking central assistance.

(d): Projects sanctioned/to be sanctioned are expected to be completed within the period of execution specified in Detailed Project Reports.
